Summary:

The department wishes to partner with Immigrations and Customs Enforcement under the Task Force Model of the 287(G) Program.

Background:

The 287(g) Program is a voluntary partnership between ICE and state or local law-enforcement agencies. Created by Congress in 1996, it allows ICE to delegate specific immigration-enforcement duties to selected local officers through a written Memorandum of Agreement, or MOA. Participating officers must be approved, trained and certified by ICE, and they exercise this authority under ICE's direction and supervision. It does not automatically make every department member an immigration officer or give unrestricted immigration authority.

Fiscal Impact

Cost of Requested Action:

No additional cost. ICE covers cost of training, and potentially up to \$7,500 for Equipment, \$100,000 for vehicles, Salary benefits reimbursed for the trained TFO's, and overtime funds up to 25% of Salary Department of Homeland Security.
