AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COLE CAMP, MISSOURI AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLE CAMP AND UNITED STATES IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT (ICE); PROVIDING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SAID AGREEMENT;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF COLE CAMP, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Whereas, the City of Cole Camp is a city of the fourth classification, duly organize an existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

Whereas, the city desires to cooperate with United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement for the purpose of the Cole Camp Police Department wishes to partner with Immigrations and Customs Enforcement under the Task Force Model of the 287(G) Program; and

Whereas, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been drafted which outlines the mutual roles, guidelines, and obligations of both parties; and

Whereas, the Board of Alderman finds that entering into this Memorandum of Understanding is in the best interest of the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF COLE CAMP, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1: Approval of Agreement:

The Board of Alderman hereby approves the Memorandum of Understanding by and between the City of Cole Camp, Missouri and United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth.

Section 2: Authorize to Execute

The Mayor of the City of Cole Camp is hereby authorized, directed, and empowered to execute said Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk is authorized to attest to the same and affix the official seal of the City.

Section 3: Severability Clause

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of remaining portions of the ordinance

Section 4: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Board of Alderman and approval by the Mayor.
