**Clerk Report:** A second primacy fee of \$1.36 to the residential users will be added to the July utility bill due to the increase of the new primacy fee rates from the Missouri Department of Revenue. Garage sale weekend is June 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> with the city-wide clean-up the following Friday, June 10<sup>th</sup>.

**Public Works Report:** Heath wants thank Ms. Tucker's class for the box of goodies and the LSA 7 & 8<sup>th</sup> grade classes for help at the parks. Heath is working on getting the clarifier fixed. The storm water gate repair is waiting on a part being rebuilt. Heath passed the Class "C" Sewer test.

**Police Report:** Nuisance letters have been sent out and notices have been put on doors for tall grass. Chief Canfield gave a run down on traffic stops, reports, tickets, etc.... Rick Brandt gave his resignation letter as a full-time police officer effective on May 30, 2022. Rick is willing to work as a reserved officer until a replacement is found.

**Mayor Report:** The mayor thanks the city department heads for all their hard work. Mayor Meuschke gave a run down on what he has been doing and what he is working on for the city.
