### Summary:

The department is transitioning to Missouri's Law Enforcement Traffic System (LETS) for electronic crash reporting. This system reduces paperwork, improves reporting accuracy, streamlines report submission, and provides more efficient access to crash data for law enforcement and state traffic safety programs.

### Background:

The Missouri Law Enforcement Traffic System (LETS) is the statewide electronic traffic crash reporting system utilized by law enforcement agencies across Missouri. Developed to modernize the crash reporting process, LETS allows officers to complete and submit traffic crash reports electronically, replacing many traditional paper-based reporting methods.

The system standardizes crash data collection statewide, improves report accuracy, reduces administrative workload, and provides more timely crash information to the Missouri State Highway Patrol and other traffic safety stakeholders. LETS supports law enforcement agencies in meeting state reporting requirements while improving the efficiency of crash investigations and records management.
