WHEREAS, by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Cole Camp, Missouri as follows:

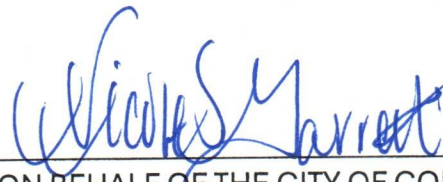

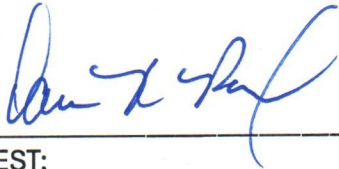
Chief Operator Agreement – Wastewater

The City of Cole Camp, Missouri (the "City") hereby enters into an agreement with Sedalia Septic and Drain & Doug Needy, Missouri WW C #10033 (the "Operator"). Operator agrees to be the Chief Operator of the Cole Camp Wastewater Treatment Facility for the duration of this Agreement. The effective date of this Agreement is Tuesday, September 1, 2026, and shall be for a term of one (1) year, with an automatic renewal for subsequent one (1) year terms unless otherwise terminated as provided herein.

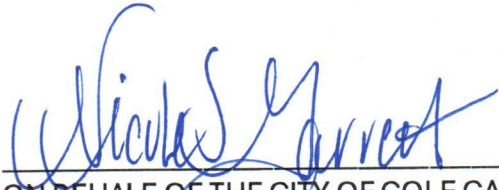
The parties agree as follows:

1. Operator agrees to the amount of \$1,600.00 per month as contract labor for the City of Cole Camp, MO, in exchange for oversight of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources reporting requirements, potential inspections, permit applications and other tasks reasonably necessary to perform the duties of Chief Operator of the Cole Camp Wastewater Treatment Facility. Additional professional services will be billed at \$125.00 per hour as approved by the Mayor or Public Works Director.
2. Operator duties and responsibilities will include oversight of the following:
 - a. Periodic sampling and administrative review as required by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources,
 - b. Regular monitoring of wastewater treatment facility activities onsite, a minimum of 16 hours per month,
 - c. Operator consultation, and
 - d. Routine DNR communication in conjunction with the Mayor and Public Works Director.
3. Operator will be required to maintain a Level C Certification.
4. Operator will be available in case of an emergency to arrive at the place of emergency within 1 hour.
5. In the event the Operator cannot be available for routine duties, he will notify the Mayor or the Public Works Director as quickly as possible. Planned absences should be given notice at least 72 hours in advance.
6. The parties agree that nothing herein shall be construed to establish an employer-employee relationship between City and Operator, and the parties expressly agree that Operator is not an employee of the City.
7. Either party may terminate the agreement with 30 days written notice.
8. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Missouri, and the venue for any action arising out of this Agreement shall be the Circuit Court of Benton County, Missouri.

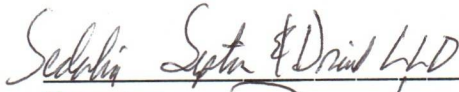
9. If any portion of this Agreement is deemed unconscionable or otherwise rendered to be of no effect, that offending portion shall be severable from this Agreement, with all other non-offending provisions remaining in full force and effect.
10. Operator agrees to maintain the necessary insurance required under Missouri law for the duration of this Agreement.
